

Trans/nonbinary youth & families: Join the Growing Up Trans Study International!

- Are you a *trans or nonbinary (TNB) youth* between 8 and 14 years old seeking gender care (such as puberty blockers or hormones) **OR** the *parent/caregiver or sibling of a TNB youth* seeking gender-affirming care?
- Do you live in the Northeast (CT, MA, ME, NH, NJ, NY, PA, RI, or VT)?
- Are you willing to be *interviewed by secure videoconference once per year for four years*?

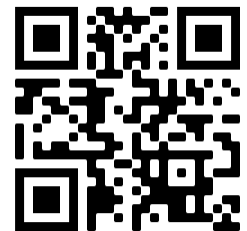
If so, you are invited to take part in virtual individual and family interviews for a study about TNB youth & their families wishing to access gender care, such as puberty blockers or hormones, including their gender affirmation experiences and their well-being.

All information you share will be kept confidential. No travel is required, and interviews will take place remotely from the comfort of your own home.

You would participate in one interview (of 2 hours or less) per year and answer some demographic questions. In Year 1, your family will do one interview together; in Years 2-4, interviews will be one-on-one.

Each participant will receive a gift card (\$35) for participation in each interview.
